Kono Sauvignon Blanc 2024 Marlborough New Zealand £13.00 Vegan

Inviting nose of lime and lemon sherbet flavours bright, soft, smooth and very refreshing, with a dash of lemon on the finish. Family-owned artisan Māori producer of award-winning wine. *Double Gold Sakura Japan Women's Wine Awards HK International Wine and Spirit Competition Gold*



Hartenberg, Chardonnay 2022 Stellenbosch, South Africa £14.50 Vegan

Hartenberg has a History perhaps older than most of the old world countries. Beginning in 1692 it makes some of the best wines in South Africa. Guillemarine Picpoul de Pinet France 2024 £12.50 Organic principals, Vegan

Domaine de Guillemarine has been in the same family for generations. Delicious, has classic aromas of white flowers and stone fruit. Crisp, refreshing and full of flavour with pear, lemon and pineapple fruits mingled with floral notes. *92 Points Decanter Silver Medal.*



Villa Blanche Syrah Calmel & Joseph 2024 Languedoc £13.50

The nose is expressive, with blackberry, plum, fresh fig and crushed strawberry. Tannins are well integrated, supple, and smooth, with aromas of strawberry and blackcurrant accompanied by mocha, vanilla and a discreet touch of black pepper on the finish. An altitude Syrah of great elegance that is both structured and luscious. *Gold medal Syrah du Monde 2025*



Luigi Bosca La Linda Malbec 2024 Argentina £12.50 Vegan

Distinctive intense deep red colour. Cherry and spicy aromas. It displays balanced tannins obtained after ageing in French oak for three months. It is a velvety, elegant and modern wine with a sound structure and the best Malbec for this kind of money. *Gold Medal International Wine Challenge 95 Points International Wine Challenge.*



Château Viranel, Intuition Rouge 2017 France £15.00

Based in Saint-Chinian and run by the Bergasse family since the 16th century. Rich and expressive, revealing layers of morello cherry, violet, and a touch of liquorice. Opens with a refreshing burst of blackcurrant, followed by a generous, fleshy texture supported by smooth, velvety tannins. Well-balanced and elegant, it finishes long and refined, with delicate hints of mocha.
