Montado Tempranillo Spain £10.00

Bright ruby in colour, notes of toast and vanilla on the nose. The palate delivers juicy sweet berry fruits a fresh and lively profile and good structure.

Rioja Carlos Serres Spain £10.00

Dark brooding colour with aromas of red and black fruit, liquorish and rustic earthy notes. Dark fruit in the mouth which is intense and long.

Les Larcins Cotes Du Rhone France £13.00

A medium bodied and quite generous Rhone red. Firm but no hard edges, cassis, hedgerow fruits and summer herbs. A little silky tannin and some good black pepper and spice to finish.

Cantina di Negrar Corvina Italy £11.00

Corvina is the queen of Veronese red grapes, typical of Valpolicella. Ruby red in colour with garnet reflections. Spicy aromas with notes of vanilla and hints of black cherry. Soft and round taste with sweet tannins that blend well with the wine's texture. The finish is long, ending with spicy tones.

KWV Classic Shiraz Western Cape, South Africa £12.00

The classic Shiraz displays sophisticated aromas of raspberries and black cherry with notes of dark chocolate, pepper and soft smoky oak flavours.
